PALÁCIO DO CORREIO-MOR

Palácio do Correio-Mor, conceived by the Italian architect António Canevari in the 18th century, is one of the most remarkable Palaces in the outskirts of Lisbon due to its elegant decoration in stucco, tiles and paintings. In 1967 it was classified as Patrimony of Public Interest.

In the outer space of the Palace we find a protected Mediterranean forest, waterfalls and boxwood gardens of French style. The surroundings of this Palace are unique for the cadence of the woods full of alleys and gardens, the inside rooms with tiles and stucco ceilings with paintings by José da Costa Negreiros are absolutely astonishing.

Festa Aluga, in partnership with HBCV, intends to take advantage of this environment through the implementation of a tent with capacity up to 800 people, allowing all type of events from private to weddings and business events.

15 minutes away from Lisbon city center, this venue combines a unique country and romantic setting, with a Baroque style Palace that features events of all types.











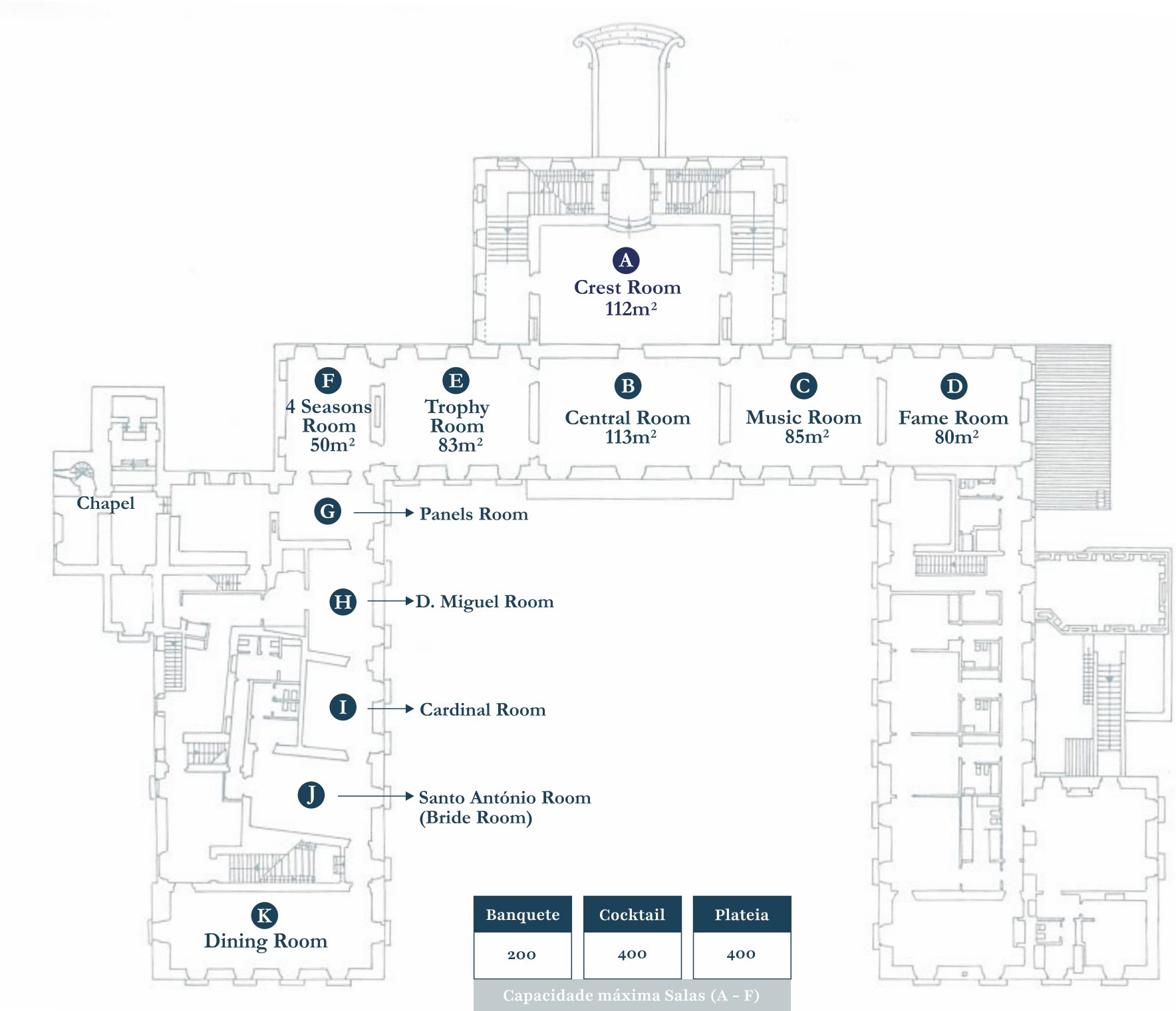

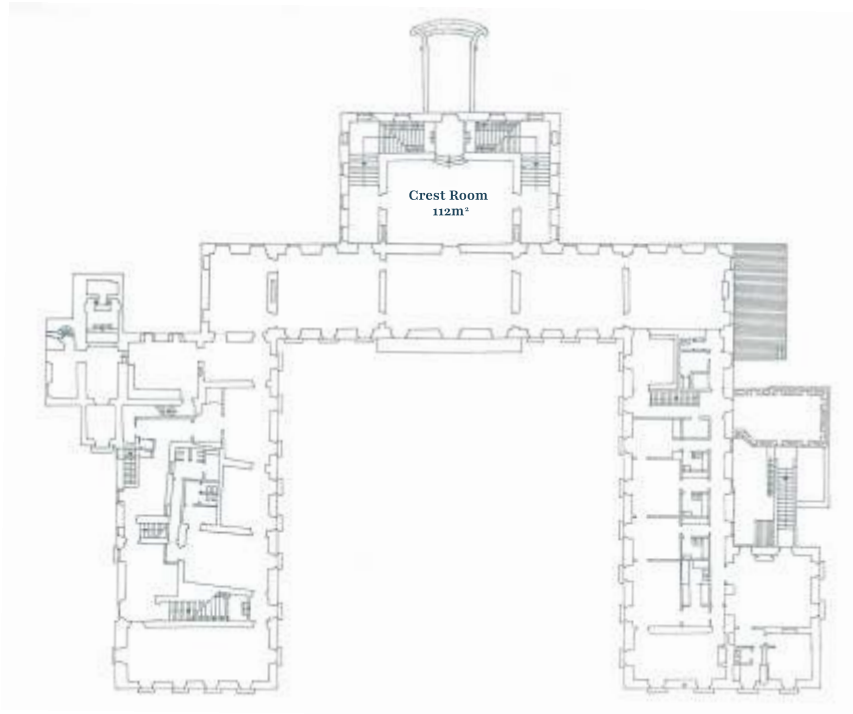

Crest Room

Here we can find the Family Crest's of the Palace. The floors are a replica of the Royal Convent of Mafra, the most important baroque monument in Portugal.



Crest Room

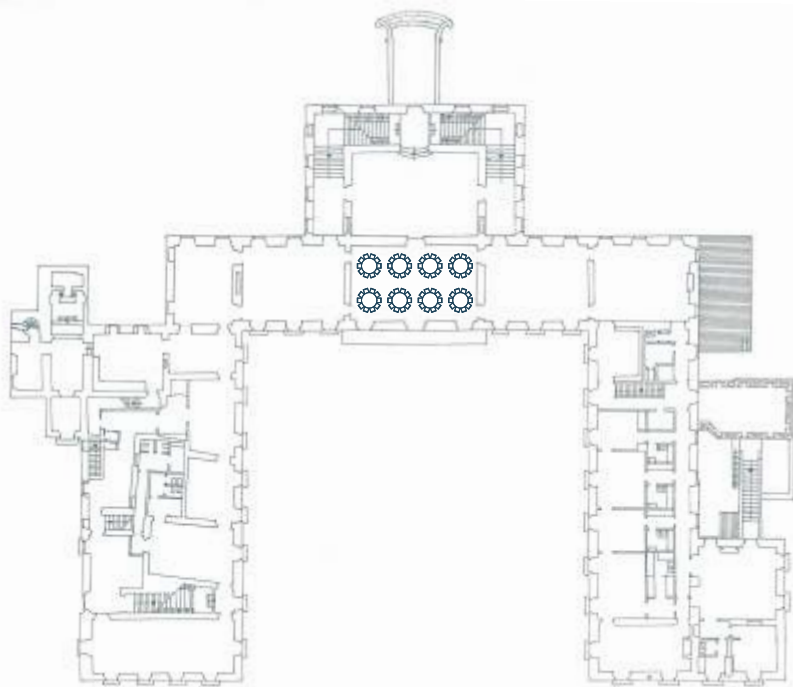


Central Room

All the rooms and chapel are richly covered with tiles from different periods, with different representations before the 1755 earthquake.

This Room is decorated by a Panel of Tiles dating from 1760. It is part of a set of panels that represent the ages of man, compared to the phases of a ship's life.

This 113m² room has a capacity for 8 round tables measuring 1.60m, which seat a total of 80 people.



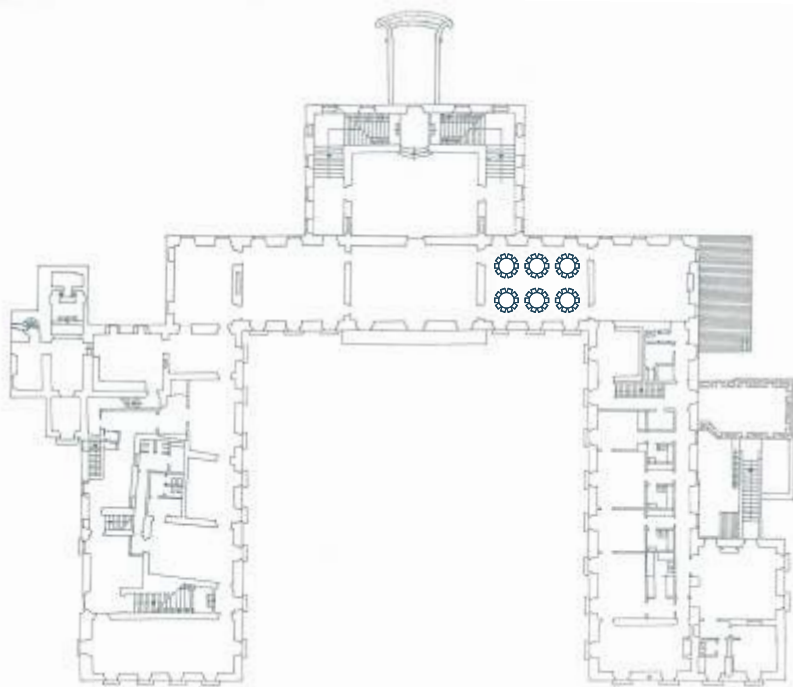




Music Room

Josephine style room, with paintings of several musical instruments, and an over door that shows a large ship with the Portuguese flag.

This 85m² room has a capacity for 6 round tables measuring 1.60m, which seat a total of 60 people.



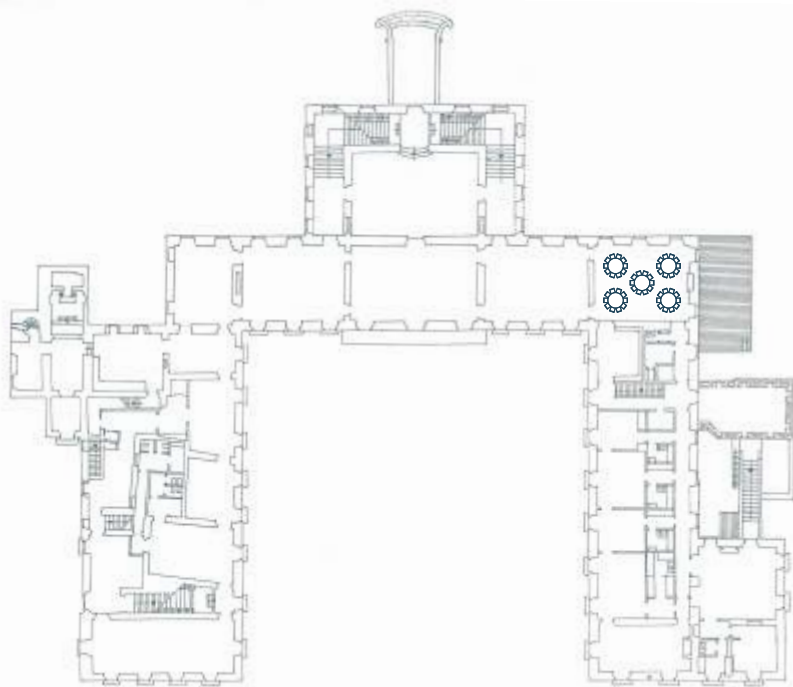




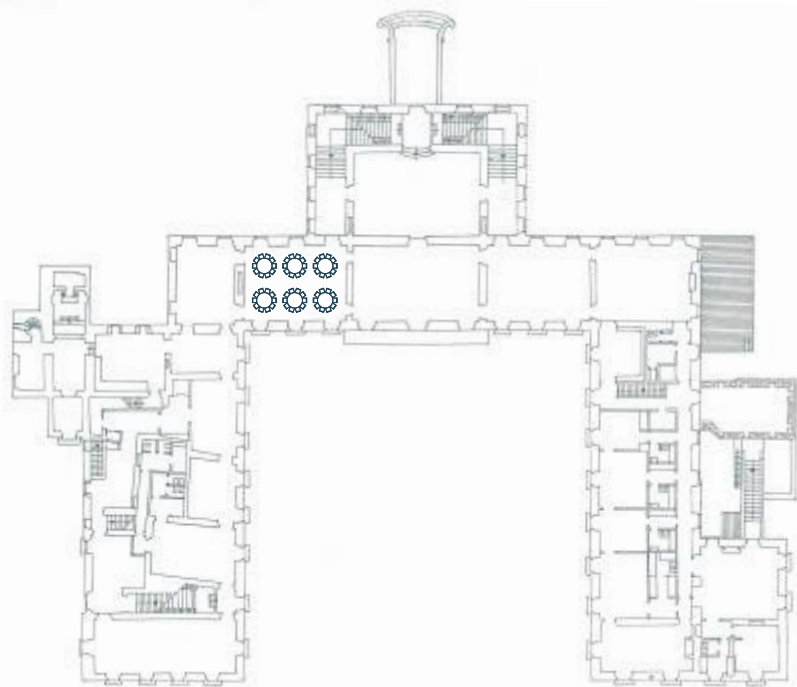
Fame Room

On the stucco ceiling the paintings represent four continents: Europe, Africa, America and Asia. On the walls, the tile panels show Torre de Belém and Terreiro do Paço before the earthquake of 1755.

This 80m² room has a capacity for 5 round tables measuring 1.60m, which seat a total of 50 people.





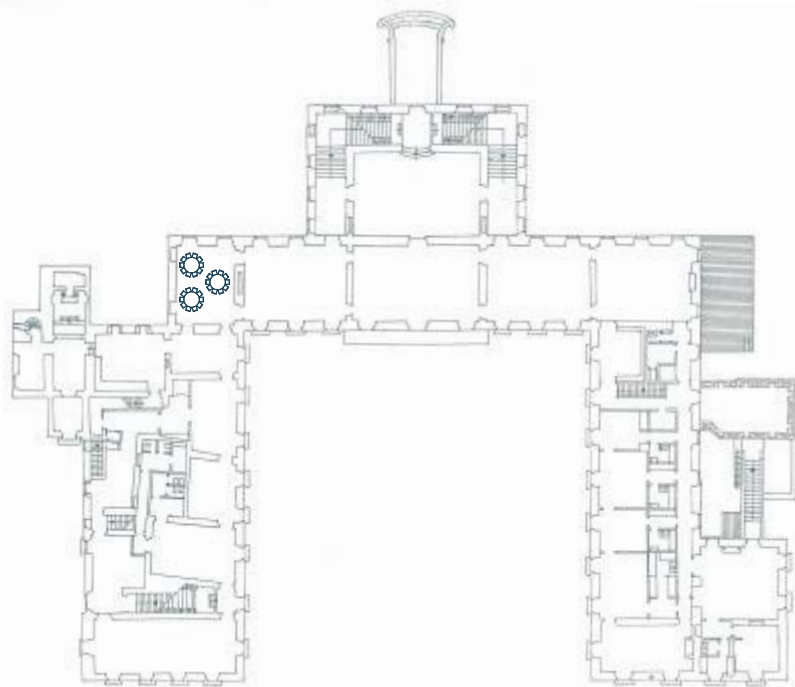


Trophy Room

In the central area of this stucco ceiling, a mythological scene is represented, surrounded by trophies that give this room its name.

This 83m² room has a capacity for 6 round tables measuring 1.60m, which seat a total of 60 people.





Four Seasons Room

Room decorated with tile panels dating from 1755, representing the four seasons of the year.

This 50m² room has a capacity for 3 round tables measuring 1.80m, which seat a total of 36 people.
